



## **Temecula Student Center Da Vinci Middle (6-8) FAQ's**

### **What makes you different from the school down the street?**

Our teachers are mentors and referred to as Teacher of Record. Teachers guide students in the learning process. We are a project based, personalized learning academy. We implement Common Core with hands on learning and activities. We are a 4 day a week academy with 1 optional, home study day.

### **What about Electives?**

Encore is the name for our elective days. Our middle school rotates through many different electives a semester on Friday. This provides an opportunity for students to explore creativity and artistic skills to help them in their academics.

### **Since Monday is optional, how do we opt out?**

Parents should contact the Teacher of Record and request an Opt Out form to fill out. Students turn in the opt out form in lieu of attending class. The student will complete activities at home during this day.

### **In addition to middle school, what other grades do you service at the Temecula Student Center and is there tuition?**

We are a free public charter school. We also have the DaVinci Elementary Academy that serves K-5 and the Renaissance Real World High School Academy that serves grades 9-12.

### **Is Springs Charter School implementing Common Core?**

Yes, Springs Charter School is a public funded school and therefore follows state standards, including testing. The Temecula Student Center embraces common core as we naturally teach to a high rigor and relevance with an art based focus.

### **Do students have P.E.?**

Yes, Middle school offers P.E. throughout the week.

### **How do parents stay current with grades and classroom assignments?**

We have online classroom programs through Canvas which holds daily assignments. They are available for home study days and when students are absent. Canvas houses each class and the class expectations for students and parents. Illuminate is used for scheduling and attendance purposes. Our school provides all necessary computers and software. Students are discouraged from bringing to school their personal electronic devices.

### **What are Home Study Days?**

We are a homeschool charter and as part of Springs' vision our school consist of traditional classroom instruction plus a minimum 1 day a month home study day. On home study days, students do not attend school. These days are designated to empower and partner with parents in their child's education.

### **What happens if my student is active in sports or other extracurricular activities that take them away from the classroom?**

Students must inform their teacher of record of absences and create an exceptional circumstances contract to assure work is being completed daily and students stay academically successful. If a student will miss class, they complete assignments using Canvas.

### **How much homework will my child have each night?**

The DaVinci Academy strives to allow family time. Your children will always have mathematics and reading. Other subjects focus on long term projects that students will work on in class and on occasion at home.

**Does your academy offer after school activities or clubs?**

We offer dances, leadership, yearbook, a large variety of student clubs and various community events. We offer clubs based on student interest. Students submit a club idea and get a teacher to sponsor the club. Once this is submitted, it is either approved or denied.

**Is Temecula Student Center a closed campus?**

Yes, students must be checked out by a parent and signed back in to return. Students can not walk off campus for lunch.

**Does TSC have a dress code?**

TSC does have a dress code. We ask that you review the school handbook for all school policies, rules and expectations. The handbook can be accessed on the school website, SpringsCS.org under Temecula Student Center Parent Forms.

**Do you offer tutoring?**

Yes. Teachers set up their own tutoring schedule for each class.

**What is the best way to communicate with teachers and the administration?**

Our school sends out weekly electronic emails with dates and reminders for K-12. The principal also conducts various town hall meetings. The Teacher of Record(TOR) will also send out academic progress notices every learning period. Also, our entire school staff is readily available via email.

**What is a learning period?**

Every 20 school days constitutes a learning period. Progress is measured at the end of each learning period. If a student does not make academic progress, with a 2.0 GPA or above for two consecutive learning periods in a row, a letter/email is sent home informing the family and requesting a meeting.

**Does Temecula Student Center have a hot lunch program?**

The students bring lunch from home on their full days.

**Are all teachers highly qualified?**

All teachers are credentialed and hold a highly qualified standing within the state.

**Can I tour Temecula Student Center?**

During the school year tours are conducted Wednesdays at 10:15am. Check website for summer tours.

**Is parent involvement mandatory?**

We ask that all parents attend two Personalized Learning meetings a year, with their mentor teacher, to create goals for their students.

**Do you offer field trips?**

Our vision is to connect our students to their community. Therefore, grades K-8 will have an average of 1 field trip per month. Some field trips are parent driven, others charter a bus.

**Can parents chaperone field trips?**

Yes, they must be pre approved before attending any field trip. Interested parents may request a form in the front office and fill out a Megan's Law Clearance Form. Because our chaperones receive a discounted price, they must be willing to ride the bus and watch a group of children. Siblings are not permitted on field trips.

**What about medication?**

Parents should contact the School Nurse at 951-252-8833 and pick up the Medication Authorization Forms from the front desk. Students are not allowed to carry over the counter or prescribed medicine with them.
