

Cereal Box Book Reviews

Requirements:

You may choose any fiction book of your choice. It is a good idea to choose a chapter book as they lend themselves easier to this process.

The report will be presented on a covered cereal box. You may wrap the box in any kind of colored, patterned or textured paper that you choose. Let your imagination run wild but be sure that we can easily read your report.

You may use glitter, stickers, scrapbooking supplies or decorations.

You need to include the following information on your box:

Title, author and illustrator and at least one illustration you create
theme of the book or the setting


a summary

a review / be sure to include your opinion or favorite parts

the main characters,

student creator's name

an item that represents your book and fits inside the box



Directions:

- 1 - Use paper to wrap the box like a present but be sure to leave an opening at the top for the item you will hide inside. (Go easy on the tape!)
- 2 - Decorate the front of the box - please include the title, author's name and a drawing that symbolizing the book - please create one yourself and come up with an idea that is different than the cover of the book. It is ok to use clipart or stickers here.
3. Use templates or plan out how to put the rest of the required elements onto the box. Be sure your information is neat, colorful and gives others a good idea of why you chose this book
4. Choose an item that represents to story to hide inside the box

5. Please bring your completed box and a copy of the book with you to display at the Reading Extravaganza!
