On this epic voyage they must abandon everything that is familiar to them and adapt to the new demands of shipboard life This voyage will take students three quarters of the way around the world and traverse the infamous "Roaring Forties." Life promises to be challenging as students must communicate and work together in order to survive. The skills they learn, however, will become invaluable in helping to prepare for an uncertain future in the New World.

►ADVENTURE TOUR GRADES K-3, 10:00AM-2:00PM RECOMMENDED FOR KINDERGARTEN-3RD GRADE LEVELS

The Adventure Tour offers a unique hands-on approach opportunity to teach students about Pirates and the Sailors life during the 18th century by exploring real life exhibits and participating in hands on activities. The program includes:

- Guided tour by our Education staff of the Star of India (World's oldest active tall-ship) with a sail raising activity
- Rowing lesson and rowing out on San Diego Bay aboard one of our longboats
- Black powder gun or cannon demonstration on the Museum barge
- 45 minute tour around San Diego Bay on the historic 1914 Pilot Boat

After the program, you can take a self guided tour of the Museum's other ships and submarines including the HMS Surprise (featured in Master and Commander and Pirates of the Caribbean 4) as well as the USS Dolphin (deepest diving submarine) at your own pace. (subject to availability)
