- ◆ All students must be accompanied by a registered adult.

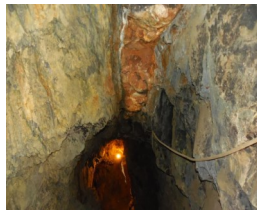

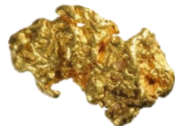
Students will also learn about the tools, machinery, and old milling and extraction processes used by early Californians .
